

WHY HIRE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FOR A JOB?

What's OPT?

OPT is a temporary employment authorization that allows international students to work in the U.S. for up to 12 months after completing their degree. It is a critical pathway for students to gain professional experience and contribute to the U.S. economy.

How long can a student work on OPT?

Students can work on OPT for up to 12 months. For students with a master's degree, the duration can be extended to 36 months.

What happens after OPT ends for a student?

After OPT ends, students must either find a job that sponsors them for an H-1B visa, return to their home country, or apply for a different visa status. Many students find employment through their OPT experience, which provides a significant advantage in the job market.
