On February 7th, the Honors Forum hosted a dialogue entitled "Do We Really Have a Climate Crisis and Can It Be Solved? A Conversation on The Future of the Climate and Humanity Response". The debate featured two noteworthy speakers: Orrin G. Woodward of the Manhattan Institute and Dr. Cassidy L. Jones of the Center for Global and Environmental Policy Studies. Dr. Woodward was a senior advisor for Mitt Romney's 2012 presidential campaign, and Dr. Andrew Revkin, award-winning author and Advisor for Environmental and Science Journalism for the National Geographic Society.



The event kicked off with both speakers addressing the audience. Tackling the debate respectfully from two different sides, Cass and Revkin set the tone for an evening of good-spirited, informed conversation in the name of solutions and engagement with issues related to climate change. From there, the night's moderators moved the talk toward topics like the Paris Agreement, the science and economic implications of climate change, and the role of government in addressing environmental issues. The evening concluded with a lively question and answer portion featuring students and members of the community.
