9. New Business

a. Overview of the Student Events Council

i. Introduction by SEC Chair Bailey Gerson, SEC Vice Chair Bennett Metzger, and SEC Treasurer Nila Rothman

1. Gerson, Metzger, and Rothman introduced themselves. Gerson overviewed the organizational and procedural changes made to the Student Events Council (previously the Student Entertainment Committee) during bylaw review process. Gerson described the four SEC subcommittees: the SEC Subcommittee on Major Events, the SEC Subcommittee on Campus Events, the SEC Subcommittee on Campus Traditions, and the SEC Subcommittee on C. Maxwell reminded the Senate that the SEC Chair, SEC Vice Chair, and SEC Treasurer are the three elected members of SEC.

ii. Q/A Period

1. Associate Director of Leadership Activities Emily Poole asked about meeting times. Gerson replied that SEC meets on Wednesdays. S. Kostbar asked about potential ideas for the Spring Fling. Gerson answered that ideas are in the works. S. Chen asked about student attendance at SEC events. Gerson answered that there are currently over 720 RSVPs for Big Show, and that over 100 students attended the Movie Night. S. Ziek asked for examples of recurring SEC events. Gerson replied that Big Show and Earth Day are the most notable, but also mentioned Junior Ring, Spring Fling, and Senior Week. S. Flamenbaum asked if there is an event this Friday. Gerson replied that SEC is hosting pumpkin painting on Case Green at 4pm. S. Flamenbaum asked

involvement in SEC. Gerson noted that between five and eight first-year students consistently attend meetings. S. Ochoa asked about the degree to which events are based on student feedback. Gerson answered that forms are consistently sent out for student feedback. Poole added that event ideas are always appreciated.

1. Introduction by SGA President Maxwell
